* Full Pay Discount included; discount is applied to standard tuition rates only. Single payment amount applies if paid by July 1st.

- Families with more than one child receive a multi-student discount. The child with the highest tuition will pay the first child rate.
- A one-time Campus Fund Fee (\$400/new family) is in addition to the above tuition amounts for Kindergarten – Grade 12. These fees are not eligible for any discounts and not prorated.
- All payments are processed through FACTS on a direct payment system. Monthly payments are August to May, processed on the 1st, 5th, 15th, or 20th of each month. Full year, semester, or quarter payments will be due prior to the start of the semester/quarter and are also paid through FACTS.

TUITION DISCOUNTS/CREDITS (See Student Handbook for complete policies; discounts may not be combined unless noted below.)

Full Year Payment Discount:	A 2% tuition discount is available for accounts paid in full on or before July 1 st ; not eligible with variable tuition.
New Student Referral Program:	\$200 tuition credit for current PCA family for each new family who is referred, enrolls, and attends PCA. May be combined with other discounts/credits.
Grandparent Tuition Credit:	Grandparents paying for their grandchildren’s tuition will receive a credit of \$500 per year.
Military Discount:	A 10% tuition discount is available for current Active Duty military. (Must present valid ID).
40th Anniversary PCA Graduate Discount:	A 10% tuition discount is available for any child of a PCA high school graduate.

FEES

Due at Time of Enrollment (Enrollment Fees are Non-Refundable)

New Enrollment	Early Education: \$ 350 per student - Due when application is submitted. K – Grade 12: \$ 400 per student - Due when application is submitted.
Continuous Enrollment	Early Education: \$ 300 per student – Due when continuous enrollment is submitted in FACTS. K – Grade 11: \$ 350 per student – Due when continuous enrollment is submitted in FACTS.

Incidental costs such as lunches, seasonal items, sports fees, student trips, etc. are not covered by the above fees.

Tuition will remain unchanged if instruction moves to remote learning.

WITHDRAWAL: When a student withdraws, the tuition will be prorated to the last day of enrollment. Any eligible refund is first subject to deduction of outstanding balances. Report card(s), transcript(s), and diploma(s) are held until ALL financial obligations are paid in full.
